Mode of Assessment:

Written Assessment:

- The LSP shall administer a **30** multiple choice question (MCQ) test.
- The total allocated time for the written assessment is 1 hour.
- The passing mark for the written assessment is 60%.



Practical Assessment:

- Each learner is expected to complete and pass ALL the assessment requirements within the stipulated assessment time allocated.
- The learner shall be assessed either “Competent” or “Not Yet Competent”. 100% pass for all the practical components is required.
- A judgment on the competency of the worker shall be made based on the evidence gathered during the practical assessment.

Certification:

- Participants who have successfully completed the course and assessment, a certificate of achievement endorsed by Vision Global Engineering & Safety Services Pte. Ltd. will be issued to all participants.

Course administration instructions:
